Our classrooms are filled with visual supports and timetables for students to use to help guide them through their day. Sometimes these can be used at home to help our young people transition to and from school. Let us know if you would like any resources to support creating visual timetables in your home.

This week I can share some of our class Kindness Goals for Term 2:

So, what is kindness? To me kindness is about being nice to others, even when it's not easy. And it's important to me because focussing on kindness helps develop empathy. In fact, kindness and empathy are like two peas in a pod! They often go hand in hand. Kindness is taking action to help someone or make them feel better. When you're empathetic, you're better able to understand what someone might need, and that makes it easier to show kindness toward them. Focussing on kindness helps us develop empathy and understanding.

I have formed a Kindness Squad to be on the lookout for Kindness in our school. Last week on

assembly we celebrated four kindness superheroes:

All our young people can be kindness superheroes! This week I encourage our students to look for opportunities to be kind to friends, family, teachers, and visitors. We never know how much a small act of kindness can brighten someone's day.


